



Under control: strong winds fuelled a fire in Oranjezicht yesterday which headed towards homes, but firefighters managed to bring it under control. By late yesterday most of the blaze was out, but large areas of veld were still smouldering. Philip Prins, Table Mountain National Park fire chief, said the fire had been started in the quarry off Glencoe Road, probably by a vagrant. He said the SA National Parks helicopter was used to douse the flames. Firefighters would remain on the scene to make sure the fire did not flare up again.
